

During the first two weeks of the school year, Titusville Area School District will distribute school meals to students of the district on their online learning day. Students who are physically coming to school two days per week are eligible for meal service on their online learning days. The curb side pick-up points are Titusville Middle School, Pleasantville Elementary School and Hydetown Elementary School. Meals are available from 4:30 PM until 5:30 PM. For the first week, the pick-up days are Monday, August 31st and Thursday, September 3rd. For the second week, pick-up will be Tuesday, September 8th and Thursday, September 10th.

To sign up to receive meals for the first two weeks, please complete an electronic form that is found [here](#). If you have multiple students in your household, please complete the survey individually for each student. You will also need to designate which pick up location you will use.

Additionally, we are seeking your opinion. We would like to know your thoughts on having the above-mentioned free meals delivered directly to your home. The District is not delivering meals at this time, but we are gathering information to possibly do it in the future. There will be questions about this in the survey.
